August 5-7 (Monday-Wednesday)	Change period for students who selected courses during the pre-registration period. Working hours: 8:00 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. <b>Students who complete the requirements leading to a degree at the end of the semester must fill out the graduation application no later than September 20.</b>
August 7 (Wednesday)	<b>Tuition payment</b> deadline. If payment is not received, all courses will be cancelled. <sup>1</sup> Working hours: until 6:00 p.m.
August 8 (Thursday)	Enrollment analysis and data processing. <b>No registration will take place.</b>
August 9, 12, and 13 (Friday, Monday and Tuesday)	<b>Registration for students who did NOT select courses</b> during the pre-registration period. Working hours: 8:00 am – 3:30 pm
<b>August 12 (Monday)</b>	<b>DAY AND EVENING CLASSES BEGIN ON CAMPUS.</b>
August 12-14 (Monday-Wednesday)	Change of schedule period. <b>100% refund</b> period for dropped courses.
August 14 (Wednesday)	Tuition payment deadline with <b>NO</b> late fees for students who registered on August 12.
August 16 (Friday)	Tuition payment deadline <b>WITH</b> late fees. All courses will be cancelled if payment is not received by this date. Working hours: until 3:00 pm.
<b>August 17 (Saturday)</b>	<b>SATURDAY CLASSES BEGIN.</b>
August 21 (Wednesday)	Last day to <b>drop courses with a 50% tuition refund.</b> <sup>2</sup>
August 26 (Monday)	Deadline to apply for a review of <i>Academic Progress</i> in the Office of the Dean of Students.
September 2 (Monday)	<b>HOLIDAY: LABOR DAY</b>
September 13 (Friday)	Last day to request authorization to <b>enroll in classes off campus (Special Permit).</b> <sup>3-4</sup>
	Application deadline for <b>Readmission</b> in the Spring Semester <sup>3</sup> (undergraduate level). Last day for Río Piedras Campus students to apply for <b>Transfer</b> to other UPR System units. <sup>2</sup>
	Last day for schools/colleges to submit the <b>creation and/or modification</b> of courses for the Spring Semester to the Office of the Dean of Academic Affairs.
September 18 (Wednesday)	Last day for students from other universities (undergraduate level) to submit the <b>Application for Admission</b> to the Río Piedras Campus for the Spring Semester to the Office of Admissions.
	Last day to request change of <b>College/School or Major</b> (reclassification). <sup>3</sup>
September 20 (Friday)	Last day for graduation candidates to submit the <b>Graduation Application</b> for the current academic session. <sup>3</sup>
	Application deadline for the <b>achievement exams</b> option (Certification 88-2003-2004 of the Río Piedras Campus Academic Senate). <sup>3</sup>
	Academic recess for faculty meeting.
October 14** (Monday)	Monday classes that start at 4:00 p.m. and later will meet to make up for the September 23 recess due to Tropical Storm Karen.
October 15 (Tuesday)	Start date for partial academic evaluations, by professors, of students enrolled in undergraduate courses.
	Monday classes will meet to make up for a holiday. Tuesday classes will not meet.
October 16 (Wednesday)	Academic recess from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. for the student assembly.
October 17-31 (Thursday-Thursday)	Period for schools and colleges to submit <b>Authorized Course Schedules</b> for the Spring Semester to the Office of the Registrar.
October 25 (Friday)	Deadline for professors of undergraduate courses to submit <b>partial undergraduate academic evaluation reports</b> online to the Office of the Registrar.
October 28 (Monday)	Late application deadline to submit the <b>Admission by Transfer and Readmission</b> application at the undergraduate level. Applicants will pay 1.5 times the corresponding application fee.
October 29 (Tuesday)	Partial undergraduate evaluation available online (MIUPI).
November 4 (Monday)	Last day for <b>partial course withdrawal</b> from undergraduate courses.

November 11* (Monday)	REGULAR CLASS DAY: Tuesday classes that start at 12:00 p.m. and later will meet to make up for the August 27 recess due to Tropical Storm Dorian.
November 12-22 (Tuesday-Thursday)	Spring Semester <b>course selection period</b> (students must verify their college/school's internal calendar).
November 19** (Tuesday)	REGULAR CLASS DAY: Day and evening classes will meet to make up for the September 24 recess due to Tropical Storm Karen.
<b>November 23 (Saturday)</b>	<b>LAST DAY OF CLASS FOR SATURDAY CLASSES.</b>
November 28-30 (Thursday-Saturday)	Thanksgiving Recess. Academic and Administrative recess.
December 2 (Monday)	Last day for high school students to submit the <b>Admission Application</b> (subject to change by the Office of Admissions). <sup>4</sup>
December 4** (Wednesday)	REGULAR CLASS DAY: Wednesday classes meet to make up for the September 25 recess due to Tropical Storm Karen.
*December 5 (Thursday)	REGULAR CLASS DAY: Thursday classes meet to make up for the August 29 recess due to Tropical Storm Dorian.
*December 6 (Friday)	REGULAR CLASS DAY: Friday classes meet as per usual.
December 7 (Saturday)	<b>Final exams for Saturday classes.</b>
December 9 (Monday)	LAST DAY OF CLASS ON CAMPUS AND LAST DAY FOR TOTAL WITHDRAWALS. REGULAR CLASS DAY: Daytime Wednesday classes meet to make up for the October 16 student assembly recess.
December 10-18 (Tuesday to Wednesday)	<b>Final exams period on the Río Piedras Campus.</b>
December 19 (Thursday)	Last day to submit <b>final grade reports</b> to the Office of the Registrar. Last day to remove the previous semester and Summer session's incompletes.
December 23-31 (Monday-Tuesday)	<b>Academic and Administrative Recess.</b>
December 24-25 (Tuesday-Wednesday)	<b>Christmas Recess.</b>
