

COLLEGE OF SOCIAL SCIENCES TENURE TRACK FACULTY POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGY

The Department of Psychology, College of Social Sciences at the Río Piedras Campus of the University of Puerto Rico announces a search to fill a **two** full time, tenure track faculty position in the area of Clinical Psychology, to begin in August 2016.

<u>Requirements</u>: Ph. D. in Psychology from an accredited university with mayor in Clinical Psychology; capacity to contribute to the work done in Graduate and Bachelor's Degree Programs in Psychology; teaching experience at the university level and commitment to teaching at undergraduate and graduate at day and night; experience mentoring thesis and dissertations; breadth knowledge in psychological theory and research methodology; broad knowledge of therapeutic intervention models; proficiency in Spanish and English; expertise in several of the following areas: 1) Diverse modalities of psychological assessment, 2) Diversity regarding theoretical approaches and modalities of psychological intervention, 3) Consultation, 4) Supervision, 5) Clinical Skills, 6) Research in clinical practice, 7) Family Therapy.

<u>Responsibilities</u>: Engage in research and effective teaching: scholarly work in the discipline; publications and international collaborations; write external funding proposals; institutional assessment and accreditation processes; monitor research and students supervision practices; teach on different schedules including evenings and Saturday; and comply with the responsibilities included in the bylaws of the University of Puerto Rico.

Evaluation will start on April 2016 and applications will be received until the position is filled. Applications, must send: 1) cover letter describing their academic philosophy and vision research, and publication; 2) curriculum vitae; 3) copy of the academic credentials of all their degrees; 4) evidence of their research, publications and creative work; 5) three letters of recommendation send to:
