

TENURE TRACK FACULTY POSITION ANOUNCEMENT IN THE PROGRAM OF SOCIOLOGY

The Department of Sociology and Anthropology of the College of Social Sciences at the Río Piedras Campus of the University of Puerto Rico announces a search for a full time, tenure track faculty position in the Program of Sociology to begin in August 2017.

Requirements: Applicants must have a PhD or equivalent degree in Sociology or a related discipline from an accredited university; teaching experience at the higher education level; research experience in one or more of the following areas: Quantitative Methods, Methodology, and Criminology. The selected person must show capacity for publication and dissemination of his/her scholarship internationally; commitment to excellence in teaching; demonstrate knowledge of educational technologies and student learning assessment practices in courses; proficiency in Spanish and English.

Responsibilities: Teaching at undergraduate and graduate levels during the day and night, including the supervision of thesis. Conduct research and publish in his/her area of specialty. Develop proposals for fellowships, grants and external funds for the advancement individual and departmental research projects. Participate and contribute actively in department and university activities and projects, and university life, and fulfill the obligations for faculty personnel established by the Bylaws of the University of Puerto Rico.
