The University Puerto Rico School of Law is recruiting a candidate for a tenure track teaching position with an expected starting date of August 1, 2021.

Requirements:

- Juris Doctor or its equivalent and one of the following degrees: PhD, SJD, JSD or an LLM from a recognized institution;
- Willingness to assume academic responsibilities in one or more of the following areas:
 - Family Law; Tort Law; Civil Procedure; Contracts; Property; Evidence; Criminal Law; Criminal Procedure; Notary Law; or Mortgage Law.
- The candidate must be admitted to the practice of law in accordance with Puerto Rico regulations or another jurisdiction and must have oral and written command of the Spanish and English languages as well as experience in effective law teaching in person and online;
- The candidate must have academic publications in the field of Law;
- Ability for research or creative work;
- Availability to direct projects; and
- Commitment in seeking external funding.

Responsibilities:

- This is a fulltime position and the responsibilities comprise teaching in person and online, research and publication;
- Direction of graduate students in research work;
- Search for external funds; and
- All other tasks inherent to legal academia.
