EXPECTATIONS

Teams of 1 to 3 students

White papers must be between 1 and 3 pages in length, single spaced, with font size 10-12, Arial or Tahoma.

White papers must contain a technical approach section, followed by cost analysis of the idea with market assessment.

Students will have the opportunity to meet with the judges prior to submitting their ideas to discuss the topics.

Students will deliver the white papers in *.pdf* format on or before the due date.

BAE Systems judges will score the white papers and communicate consensus to each campus.
