TENURE TRACK FACULTY POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT

The Graduate School of Public Administration of the College of Social Sciences at Río Piedras Campus of the University of Puerto Rico announces their interest of considering candidates for a tenure track appointment in the specialization of Public Policy or Public Affairs, effective on January 2, 2023.

Requirements:

- Doctorate (DPA) or Doctor in Philosophy (PhD) in Public Administration with Government and Public Policy from a recognized and accredited university
- Minimum of one (1) year of teaching experience in academic university institutions, preferably in graduate level
- Experience teaching courses in areas related to social policies (e.g., problems of social equity, diversity, migration, human rights), or economic policies (e.g., fiscal policies, sustainable development, community development, social mobility), and research methods.
- Ability and willingness to teach in the modalities: face-to-face and distance learning
- Capacity for research or creative work
- Experience in:
 - Research projects linked to public administration, public policy, or public affairs issues
 - Publications related to their area of research, particularly in peer-reviewed journals, locally and internationally. Must also have experience in participating at conferences in local and international forums
 - Applying knowledge and working with government and nonprofit organizations
 - Different research methodologies (e.g., mixed, qualitative, and quantitative methods)
 - Submitting proposals and obtaining external funds for research and consulting
 - Availability and capacity to supervise master's research projects
- Experience or availability in working with accreditation processes (NASPAA, MSCHE)

Essential responsibilities:

- Face-to-face and distance learning at graduate level
- Research and publication in their area of specialty and/or in the teaching-learning area

Required documents:

- Letter of intent that reflects interest in teaching, capacity to conduct research, and research areas of interest or to work
- Updated Curriculum Vitae, signed, and dated
- Copy of an article published in a journal or a book chapter of your authorship
- Official credentials of all academic degrees earned (Bachelor's, Master's, Doctorate)
- Two recent recommendation letters
