- Experience in the use of educational technologies and distance learning
- Proficiency in Spanish and English.

- Teach face to face, hybrid and online undergraduate and graduate courses
- Teach courses that meet during day, nights and Saturdays
- Research and publish in his/her areas of specialty
- Advise students and supervise thesis and dissertations
- Develop proposals for seeking external funding
- Actively participate in university life
- Collaborate with other akin departments and programs

- Fulfill all obligations of a teaching position covered by the bylaws of the University of Puerto Rico.

- Student evaluations


