

TENURE TRACK FACULTY POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT

DEPARTMENT OF <u>COMPUTER SCIENCE</u> COLLEGE OF NATURAL SCIENCES

The Department of Computer Science, College of Natural Sciences at the Río Piedras Campus of the University of Puerto Rico announces the search for candidates for a full-time tenure track faculty position with the rank of Assistant Professor, with priority given to the area of Cybersecurity, to begin in January or August 2024. Excellent candidates in other areas of Computer Science will also be considered.

Requirements: Applicants must have a Ph.D. or equivalent degree in Computer Science or very closely related disciplines from an accredited university whose degrees are recognized by the University of Puerto Rico; teaching experience at the university level; capacity for in-person and online excellence in teaching; research experience in their area of expertise; publications in areas of expertise; commitment to seeking external funding; demonstrate knowledge in the use of educational technologies; availability to direct thesis and dissertations; and proficiency in Spanish and/or English.

Responsibilities: To teach undergraduate and graduate courses and seminars in person and online during daytime, Saturdays and evening hours; conduct research and publish in their areas of expertise in peer reviewed journals and conference proceedings; supervise theses and dissertations at the master and doctoral levels in Computer Science; develop proposals for the acquisition of external funds; participate actively in committees and departmental and university activities as well as comply with all faculty responsibilities contained in the General Regulations of the UPR.

Required documents: 1) a letter of intent describing the academic vision of the candidate; 2) a research statement (at most 2 pages) describing the developmental plan of their research area, publications, and search for external funds, 3) a teaching statement (at most 2 pages) describing their teaching philosophy; 4) updated curriculum vitae; 5) copy of official academic credentials of all degrees; 6) evidence of research, publications and creative work; 7) three recommendation letters.
