TENURE-TRACK FACULTY POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT

The Department of Physical Sciences of the College of General Studies at the University of Puerto Rico, Río Piedras Campus, announces the search for candidates for a tenure-track teaching appointment effective August 1, 2024.

**Requirements:** Candidates must have: (1) a doctoral degree from an accredited university in one of the following disciplines: Physics, Chemistry, Geology, Curriculum and Teaching in Science, History of Science or Philosophy of Science, or equivalent disciplines. In the case of a doctorate in Curriculum and Teaching of Science or in History of Science or Philosophy of Science, a Master's degree in Physics or Chemistry is required. Also, a candidate with extensive professional experience in the field of cultural heritage conservation and a Master's degree in Physics or Chemistry could be considered; (2) teaching experience in Physical Sciences; (3) experience and ability in research, creative work, and teaching; (4) experience in the dissemination of knowledge through publications of their research in peer-reviewed journals and presentations in professional activities, (5) willingness for teamwork and for inter, multi and transdisciplinary work; (6) availability to seek external funds; (7) demonstrate experience in creating and teaching of college level courses in person and remotely; (8) availability to offer courses in other departments of the College of General Studies.

**Required Documents:** (1) updated curriculum vitae, signed and dated; (2) statement of purpose in which you present or explain your professional plans for teaching, creation and research; (3) official credit transcript for all completed academic degrees; (4) evidence of research or creative work; (5) evidence of the capacity to integrate current technologies in teaching; (6) evidence of teaching in higher education institutions; (7) declaration of availability to work as thesis director; (8) evidence of experience in proposal preparation or commitment to seeking external funding; (9) three recent letters of recommendation; (10) professional certifications or evidence of particular experiences; (11) essay that exposes your educational philosophy, including your vision about the teaching of the physical sciences in the context of General Studies.
