TENURE TRACK FACULTY POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT

The Graduate School of Public Administration at the College of Social Sciences, Rio Piedras Campus, University of Puerto Rico, is actively seeking candidates for a tenure track appointment (assistant professor), effective August 1st, 2024.

Requirements:

- Doctorate (DPA) or Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) in Public Administration or Public Policy from a recognized and accredited university
- Minimum of one (1) year of teaching experience in academic university institutions, preferably at the graduate level
- Experience teaching courses in areas related to public policies (e.g., fiscal policies, social equity issues, sustainable development) and government affairs.
- Ability and willingness to teach in both face-to-face and distance learning formats.
- Demonstrated capacity for research and creative work
- Must have experience in:
 - Conducting research projects linked to public administration, public policy, or public affairs.
 - \circ $\;$ Publishing research findings in peer-reviewed journals and presenting at conferences and forums.
 - \circ $\;$ Applying knowledge at government and nonprofit organizations.
 - Utilizing various research methodologies (e.g., mixed, qualitative, and quantitative methods).
 - Securing external funding for research and consulting through proposal submissions.
- Availability and ability to supervise master's research projects
- Experience coordinating accreditation processes such as NASPAA and MSCHE, preferable
- Availability, if necessary, to coordinate the EGAP

Essential responsibilities:

- Teaching face-to-face and distance learning courses at the graduate level
- Engaging in research and publishing in the candidate's area of expertise and/or in the field of teaching and learning.
- Providing supervision of degree projects and academic advising to students
- Participating in EGAP committees

Required documents:

- Letter of intent that reflects the candidate's interest in teaching EGAP courses, ability to conduct research, and areas of interest or expertise.
- Updated Curriculum Vitae, signed, and dated
- Copy of an article, authored by the candidate, published in a peer-reviewed journal in the past 5 years
- Official transcripts for all academic degrees earned (Bachelor's, Master's, Doctorate)
- Two recent recommendation letters
