TENURE-TRACK TEACHING POSITION

The Humanities Department of the College of General Studies at the University of Puerto Rico, Río Piedras Campus, seeks to fill a tenure-track position effective August 1, 2024.

Requirements: The candidates to be considered should have: (1) a doctoral degree (PhD) in the Humanities from a recognized and accredited university, specifically in contemporary cultural history; (2) five years or more of experience in teaching courses in the humanities; (3) have performed a minimum of three presentations at local or international congresses concerning their research work in their area of specialty in the last five years; (4) have published at least three refereed articles on their research work, either in their discipline of specialty or in projects related to teaching in peer-reviewed journals in the last five years; (5) show evidence of the ability or potential to offer courses in different departments where the diverse areas included by General Studies are emphasized; (6) show evidence of being current in the information and communication technology competencies and skills required in teaching college courses; (7) show evidence of their experience in teaching university face-to-face and distance learning courses; (8) show evidence of their commitment in the preparation of research proposals and projects; (9) show evidence of their knowledge and experience with the development and administration of institutional assessment systems; (10) show evidence of their commitment and ability to seek external funding for research; (11) show evidence of their knowledge of the mission, goals and objectives of the College of General Studies and the Department of Humanities.

Required documents: (1) Updated *curriculum vitae*, signed and dated; (2) statement of purpose in which the candidate presents or exposes his professional, teaching and research plans; (3) official copies of all academic records; (4) evidence - up to three, diverse - of refereed publications, presentations, workshops, reports, or projects; (5) three recent letters of recommendation; (7) an essay outlining your educational philosophy, including your vision for teaching the humanities in the context of General Studies.
