Call for Tenure Track Teaching Appointment in Educational Leadership

The Department of Graduate Studies in the College of Education at the University of Puerto Rico, Río Piedras Campus, announces the search for candidates for a tenure-track teaching position to work in Educational Leadership with an appointment effective August 1, 2024.

Requirements: To be considered candidates must: (1) hold a doctoral degree (Ph.D. o Ed.D.) in Leadership of Educational Organizations, Administration or Education Management, or related field, from a recognized and accredited institution; (2) have experience and ability to engage in academic research, creation, and teaching in an institution of higher education; (3) have experience in disseminating knowledge through publications of research in peer-reviewed journals and presentations in professional spaces; (4) Experience in the use of technology for teaching in both face-to-face and online modalities; (5) Experience in educational leadership in complex organizations such as universities, schools, and/or community organizations related to education; (6) Fluency in Spanish and English.

Preferred qualifications: (1) Experience in educational research in local and international academic settings; (2) Academic experience in international contexts. (3) Competence in the use of software for data/information analysis. (4) Experience in directing or supervising research projects, theses, and/or dissertations. (5) Experience in seeking external funding or participating in project proposals with external funding. (6) Experience with the accreditation process of academic programs or institutions.

Responsibilities: Teach graduate-level courses related to educational leadership; conduct research in their area of specialization and disseminate it in professional venues; supervise dissertations; provide academic advising; participate in departmental committees; teach at various times using different modalities; actively participate in departmental and campus activities and projects; develop funded proposals.

Required Documents: (1) Updated curriculum vitae signed and dated on the final page; (2) Cover letter in which the candidate presents or explains: (a) their professional plans for teaching and research, (b) research capability, (c) capability for both in-person and distance teaching, (d) experience teaching at the post-secondary level, particularly at the graduate level, (e) experience in supervising theses and/or dissertations; (3) Examples of their intellectual or creative contributions (up to three copies of recent publications in peer-reviewed journals or professional sources in PDF format); (4) Two recent letters of recommendation sent directly to comite.personal.deg@upr.edu; (5) Evidence of their academic credentials (submit digital copies of transcripts for all completed academic degrees, official copies will be required for finalists).
