



Tenure Track Teaching Position Announcement

The Department of Mathematics, College of Natural Sciences at the Río Piedras Campus of the University of Puerto Rico, announces a search to fill one tenure-track position effective August 1st, 2024.

Requisites: Applicants must have: (1) A Ph.D. or equivalent degree in Mathematics or closely related disciplines from a recognized and accredited university. Special consideration will be given to candidates in Discrete Mathematics; nevertheless, exceptional candidates in any area of Mathematics could also be considered. (2) Prior experience and capacity for academic research in their specialty area. (3) Teaching experience at the university level and commitment to excellence in teaching. (4) Experience disseminating knowledge through peer-reviewed papers and presentations at professional conferences. (5) Availability for mentoring graduate students in thesis and dissertations. (6) Prior experience preparing proposals for external funds and/or commitment in the search for funding. (7) Preferably proficient in Spanish and English. Candidates who do not speak Spanish would be expected to learn the language during the probation period.

Responsibilities: To teach in-person (face to face) and online undergraduate and graduate level courses during the day, night, and Saturday. Conduct research and publish in their areas of expertise in peer-reviewed journals. Supervise thesis, dissertations, and professional practices. Develop proposals seeking external funding. Participate actively in departmental activities and projects and fulfill all other obligations of a teaching job. The responsibilities of the prospective candidate are covered by the bylaws of the University of Puerto Rico.

Required documents: (1) American Mathematical Society (AMS) cover sheet (2) updated curriculum vitae signed and dated; (3) intention letter describing their academic vision in teaching and research, research areas and publication; (4) official academic credentials of all their degrees, including grade transcripts; (5) evidence of their research, publications and creative work, including the most relevant publications, or links to ResearchID, ORCID, and Google scholar; (6) three recommendation letters.
