THE GRADUATE SCHOOL OF SOCIAL WORK, COLLEGE OF SOCIAL SCIENCES AT THE UNIVERSITY OF PUERTO RICO, RÍO PIEDRAS CAMPUS, ANNOUNCES ONE (1) TENURE TRACK APPOINTMENT AS ASSISTANT PROFESSOR FOR THE MASTER'S AND DOCTORAL PROGRAMS, EFFECTIVE AUGUST 1ST, 2024.

ONE POSITION (1) TO OFFER COURSES, SUPERVISE PROFESSIONAL PRACTICE, DIRECT THESES/DISSERTATIONS AND DEVELOP GRADUATE-LEVEL RESEARCH IN THE DISCIPLINE OF SOCIAL WORK.

Requirements:

(a) Doctoral degree in Social Work (b) Master's Degree in Social Work from a CSWE accredited institution (c) Extensive and diverse practical experience in Social Work (d) Extensive research teaching experience as Research Professor, preferably at the graduate level (e) Professional license in social work issued by the Puerto Rico Board of Examiners of Social Work Professionals and current membership.

Additional requirements and responsibilities:

(a) A research or service project; (b) Willingness to teach method and practice in Social Work and research courses both at master's and doctorate levels; (c) History of professional publications and presentations in your area of expertise in professional or academic forums; (d) Active participation in matters of community interest; (e) Experience and disposition to supervise theses of students of the Master's Program and dissertations of students in the Doctoral Program; (f) Availability to teach daytime, evenings, Saturday, in-person and distance courses; (g) Willingness and experience to develop research proposals and service projects; (h) Experience in grants preparation and engagement to seek external funding; (i) Proficiency in Spanish and English.

Required documents:

- Letter of intent indicating interest, statement of purpose outlining professional teaching and research plans and potential contribution to the GSSWBL and the UPR.
- Curriculum Vitae updated, signed and dated (including e-mail).
- Official copy of all academic records and transcripts.
- Copy of recent publications.
- Two (2) letters of recommendation.
- Other documents that demonstrates professional, academic and research work.
