Requirements:

• Ph.D. in Art History with an emphasis in Art from Latin America and the Caribbean, from an accredited university. Candidates in other areas of emphasis in Art History may also be considered.

- Teaching experience at the university level.
- Research experience in his/her field of expertise.
- Academic publications and presentations.
- Commitment to excellence in teaching.
- Demonstrate skills in the use of educational technologies and online education.
- Proficiency in Spanish and English.

Responsibilities:

- Teach face-to-face, hybrid and online undergraduate courses.
- Teach courses that meet during day, evenings and Saturdays.
- Research and publish in his/her areas of specialty.
- Advice students and supervise undergraduate research.
- Develop proposals for seeking external funding.

• Actively participate in committees, the creation of a graduate program and other tasks, as well as in university life.

• Fulfill all obligations of a teaching position covered by the bylaws of the University of Puerto Rico.

- Curriculum Vitae.

- Three recommendation letters for academic and professional work.
- Evidence of research, publications and creative work.
- Student evaluations.
