TENURE-TRACK TEACHING POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT

The Program in Interdisciplinary Studies and its Master's Degree in Cultural Agency and Administration of the College of Humanities, Río Piedras Campus at the University of Puerto Rico, announce the search for candidates for a tenure-track teaching position, effective **August 1st, 2024**.

Requirements:

- PhD in Cultural Agency, Cultural Studies or related discipline in the Humanities or Social Sciences from an accredited university
- Teaching experience at the university level, both in theoretical and research courses in fields related to cultural agency, including visual or performing arts, film or media, cultural policies, digital humanities, tourism, museums or heritage
- Professional experience in cultural agency in any of its areas, with emphasis on museums, heritage, education, community, event organization, cultural tourism, entrepreneurship, cultural policies or digital humanities
- Research experience in his/her field of expertise, with evidence of dissemination, including participation in conferences and academic publications
- Experience in the use of educational technologies and distance learning
- Proficiency in Spanish and English

Responsibilities:

- Teach undergraduate and graduate courses, including core courses of the Program in Interdisciplinary Studies and the Master's Degree in Cultural Agency and Administration
- Teach face to face, hybrid and online courses, during day, nights and Saturdays, according to the needs of the Program
- Research and publish in his/her areas of expertise
- Advise students and supervise thesis and conclusion projects
- Be available to assume academic leadership positions
- Actively participate in university life, which includes attending meetings and academic activities, collaborating on institutional committees and working as a team with other teachers and students, among other tasks
- Collaborate with other related departments and programs
- Develop alliances with cultural and community entities
- Develop proposals for seeking external funding
- Fulfill all obligations of a teaching position covered by the bylaws of the University of Puerto Rico

- Three recommendation letters for academic and professional work
