Requisites and Expectations for the Selection of the Dean of the College of Natural Sciences

Requisites

- 1. Hold a doctoral degree or an equivalent degree relevant to the Natural Sciences.
- 2. Have tenure in the Faculty of Natural Sciences at the University of Puerto Rico, Río Piedras Campus.
- 3. Provide evidence of academic excellence in undergraduate and graduate teaching.
- 4. Have an academic record that reflects excellence in research, as demonstrated by success in obtaining external funding or grants and by publications in peer-reviewed journals.
- 5. Have demonstrated administrative experience and efficiency in their performance.
- 6. Ability to communicate effectively, both orally and in writing, in Spanish and English.

Expectations

- 1. Develop a strategic plan for the Faculty of Natural Sciences that expresses a vision of participatory governance, promoting inclusion and equity.
- 2. Demonstrate leadership ability and the capacity to bring together the various sectors that make up the Faculty.
- 3. Maintain a proactive attitude toward dialogue with all sectors of the university community.
- 4. Commitment to the development, defense, and implementation of the strategic plan in collaboration with the Faculty.
- 5. Commitment to pursuing fair compensation (for students, staff, and faculty).
- 6. Commitment to ensuring the well-being of students, faculty, and staff of the Faculty of Natural Sciences.
- 7. Commitment to the development of academic programs, including teaching, research, and administration, at both the undergraduate and graduate levels.
- 8. Represent the Faculty and defend its interests and prestige before the university community and the general public.
- 9. Promote the intellectual and professional growth of the university community.
- 10. Commitment to safeguard and enhance the infrastructure, resources, and research capacities.
