TENURE-TRACK FACULTY POSITION - CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGY

The Department of Psychology at the University of Puerto Rico, Río Piedras Campus invites applications for one (1) tenure track faculty position in Clinical Psychology, effective on **January 8th, 2027**.

Minimum Qualifications:

1. Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) or, alternatively, Doctor of Psychology (PsyD) in Clinical Psychology from a recognized, accredited institution.
2. Experience teaching the foundations of psychodiagnostics assessment.
3. Experience and professional emphasis in psychological assessment, including clinical practice and supervision of assessment training.
4. Demonstrated expertise in psychological assessment and diagnosis with vulnerable populations.
5. Clinical research experience with an emphasis on psychological assessment and psychodiagnostics.
6. Demonstrated experience conducting research.
7. Record of publications in peer-reviewed journals, books, or book chapters published by recognized academic publishers.
8. Minimum of three years of university-level teaching experience, preferably at the graduate level.
9. Demonstrated experience and ability to supervise and direct dissertations.
10. Ability and willingness to teach in-person, hybrid, and online modalities.
11. Availability to teach during daytime, afternoon, evening and Saturday schedules.
12. Record of scholarly presentations at local and international conferences.
13. Evidence of international collaboration within the discipline.
14. Desirable qualification: knowledge and experience in neuropsychological assessment and social and emotional aspects of behavior.

Required Application Materials:

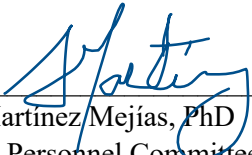
1. Letter of intent (1-2 pages) describing teaching and research experience in psychological assessment and psychodiagnostics.

3. Official documentation of all academic degrees earned (Bachelor's, Master's, Doctorate).
4. Two recent letters of recommendation.
5. Current, valid license to practice psychology issued by the Puerto Rico Board of Examiners (Department of Health of Puerto Rico) and /or an equivalent license in your current state or country.
